

- The Post 39 annual fishing tournament is scheduled for July 6. Contact Bernie Frakes for entry requirements or if you have any questions.
- The days of free on-street parking in the business district downtown and along Ruxton Avenue in Manitou Springs have ended. The city is eliminating the three-hour time limit and plans to start charging for onstreet parking this weekend (Memorial Day). Parking will be charged by the hour at one of the many payment kiosks that have been installed on Manitou, Canon, Park and Ruxton avenues. Parking rates are \$1 an hour for the first 3 hours, \$2 an hour for the next 2 hours, and \$3 an hour after 5 hours. Under that rate structure, the maximum is \$28 a day.
